Contractors realize that debris netting provides an obvious visual and physical barrier between their construction activities and the surrounding spaces.

The visual barrier gives projects a neat appearance when viewed from adjacent properties or public walks. While workers can see through the 1/4" mesh at close range, activities are less obvious at longer distances.

The physical barrier reduces the risk of falling materials, fasteners, tools and debris. While it does not replace guard rails, toeboards or other fall protection, it attaches to these components to create the feeling of a safer enclosed space.

Debris netting can be quickly unrolled, cut-to-length and fastened with cable ties (sold separately). The high-strength HDPE mesh will not tear or unravel when cut. The hemlines along each edge provide a continuous reinforced location for the cable ties. The netting can be removed and reused as work progresses on the site.

Contractors realize that debris netting is suitable for containing all kinds of construction activities, including site perimeters, scaffolding enclosures, maintenance areas, demolition projects and temporary fences.



SureNet mesh enclosures are an easy way to separate construction activities from surrounding spaces. SureNet mesh can reduce the risk of falling materials, fasteners, tools and debris.
